Let the contact at your chosen drop-off point know the B-number when you give them your bike.

# 3

We'll take it from there! The bike will make its way to one of The Bike Project's workshops to be assessed by a mechanic.

## What bike can I donate?

Our expert mechanics can fix up most bikes as long as the frame is not cracked, dented, bent or heavily rusted.

**We accept:** road bikes, vintage bikes, mountain bikes, hybrid bikes, kids bikes, balance bikes, tandem bikes

**We do NOT accept:** e-bikes, scooters, tricycles, mobility bikes, recumbent bikes, cargo bikes, frames / spare parts / accessories

## What could happen to my bike?

- It might be refurbished and donated to a refugee on our waiting list. We'll keep you updated when this happens!
- If your refurbished bike has good resale potential, we may sell it through our social enterprise (The Bike Project Shop) as its proceeds will help more than one person. Bike sales also allow us to run our engagement programmes like Pedal Power and Bike Buddies.
- If the bike is in irreparable shape, we'll dismantle it and reuse parts to rebuild other bikes. We aim to recycle as much as possible.
